Federal Government Satisfaction

Survey of Canadians



June 22, 2026



Methodology

This week, we surveyed Canadians on politics, government performance, and key national issues.

Method

Online survey among respondents 18 years of age or older.
(Canadian sample: **n= 1,528**)

Respondents had the option of completing the survey in French and English and were randomly recruited using LEO's online panel.

Weighting

Results were weighted according to **age, gender, mother tongue, region, education and presence of children in the household** in order to ensure a representative sample of the Canadian population.

When

Data collection from **June 19 to June 22, 2026**.

Margin of error

For comparison purposes, a probability sample of this size yields a margin of error no greater than **±2.5%** (19 times out of 20) for the sample.

Significant Differences

Data in bold **red** characters indicate a significantly lower proportion than that of other respondents. Conversely, data in bold **green** characters indicate a significantly higher proportion than that of other respondents.

Rounded data

The numbers presented have been rounded up. However, the numbers before rounding were used to calculate the sums presented and might therefore not correspond to the manual addition of these numbers.

Key Highlights

Some of **the key highlights** of our survey...

FEDERAL VOTING INTENTIONS

- The Liberals continue to lead nationally with 48% support among decided voters, down 2 points since June 1, while the Conservatives remain stable at 34%. Support for the NDP and Bloc Québécois stands at 6% each, while the Greens are at 4% (+1) and other parties at 2% (+1).
- Liberal support is highest in Atlantic Canada (55%), Ontario (53%), British Columbia (51%) and among Canadians aged 55 and older (57%). Conservative support remains strongest in Alberta (57%) and among rural Canadians (41%).

GOVERNMENT PERFORMANCE

- A majority of Canadians (57%) are satisfied with the federal government led by Mark Carney, up 3 points since June 1, while 36% are dissatisfied. Satisfaction is highest among Canadians aged 55 and older (63%), men (60%) and Liberal voters (93%).

PRIME MINISTER CARNEY

- Canadians' approval of Prime Minister Mark Carney's performance remains positive, with 57% approving and 35% disapproving. Approval is highest among Canadians aged 55 and older (64%), men (60%) and Liberal voters (94%).

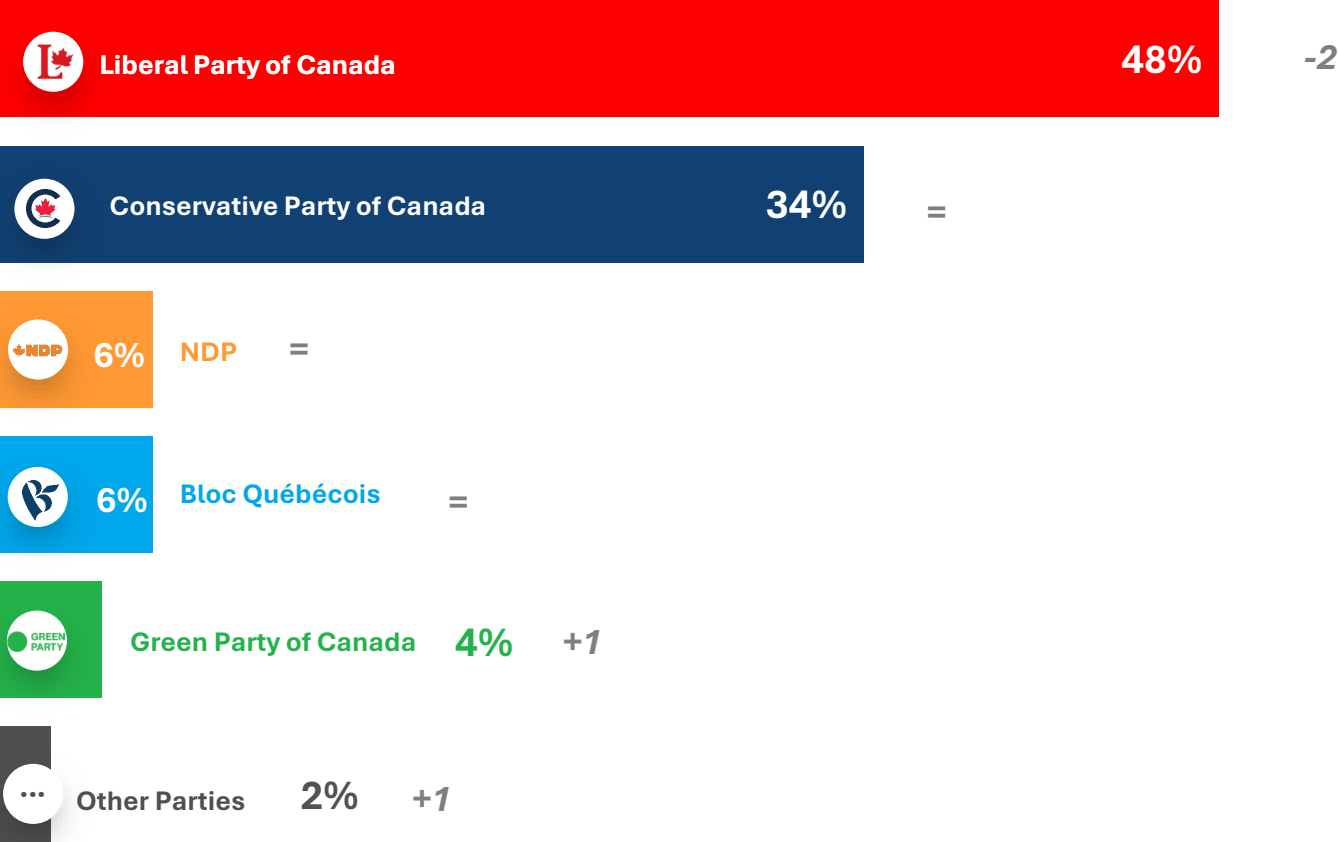

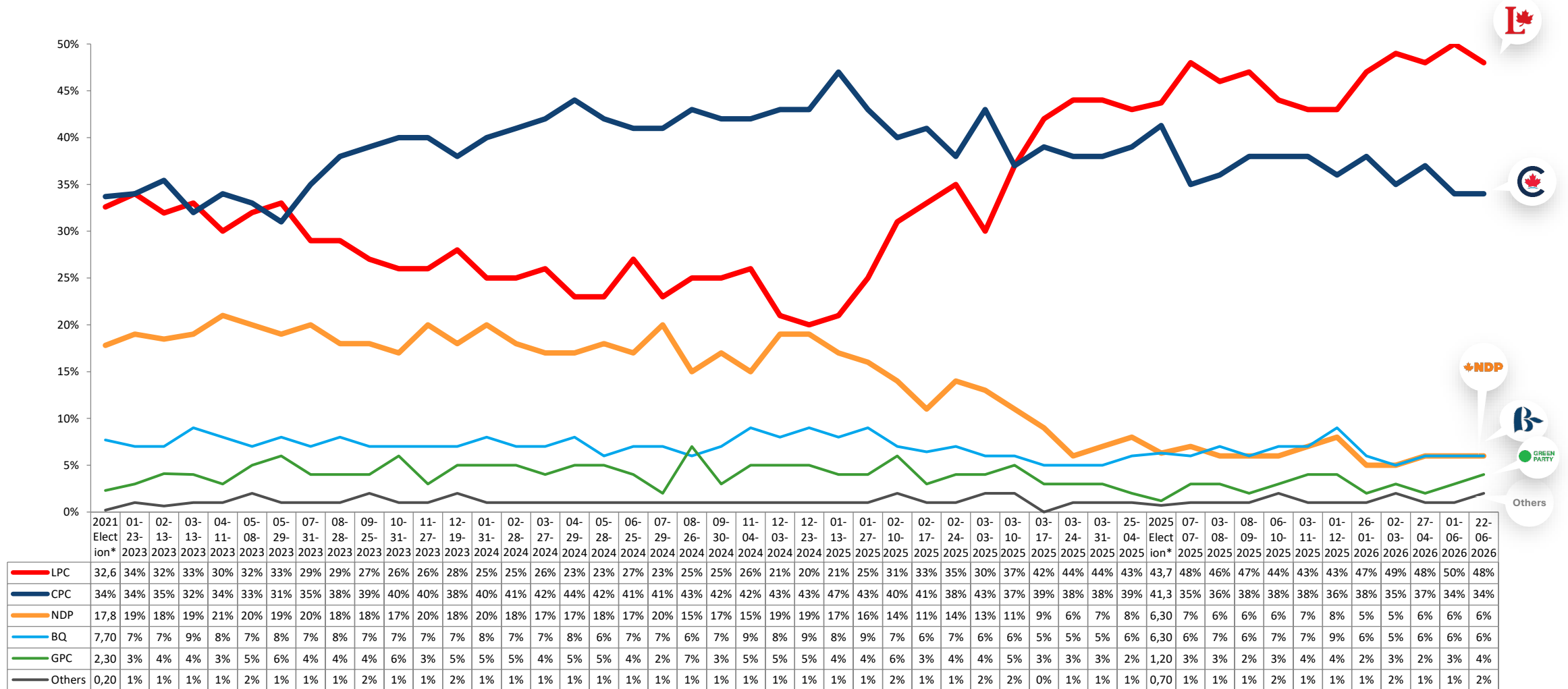

Evolution of Voting Intentions in Canada



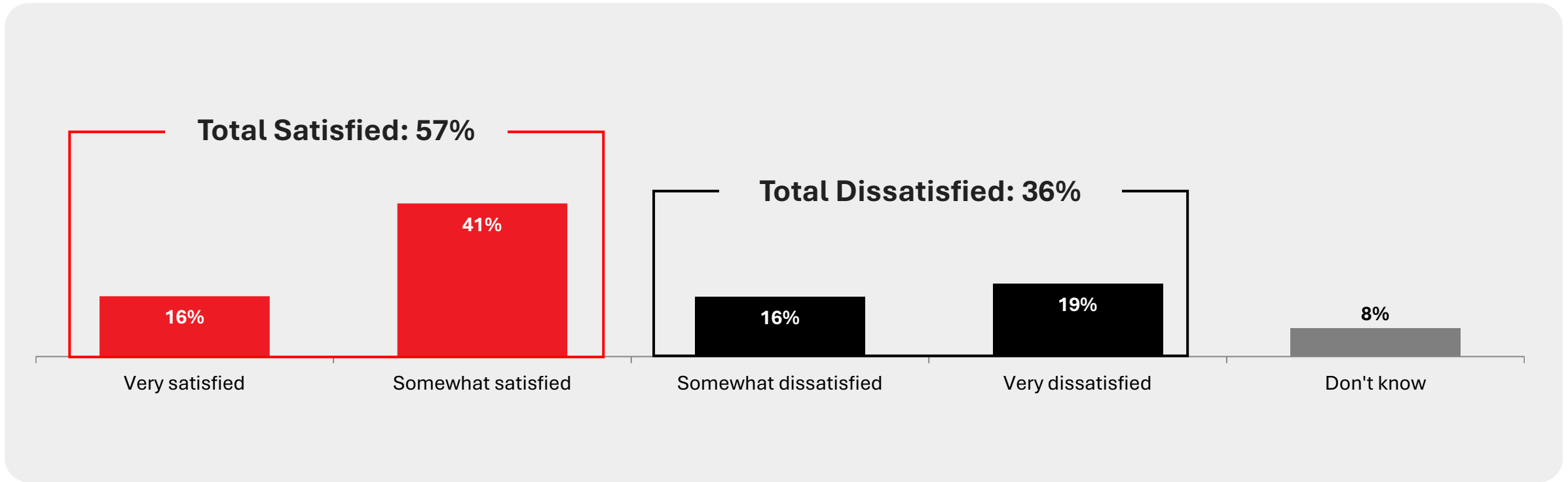

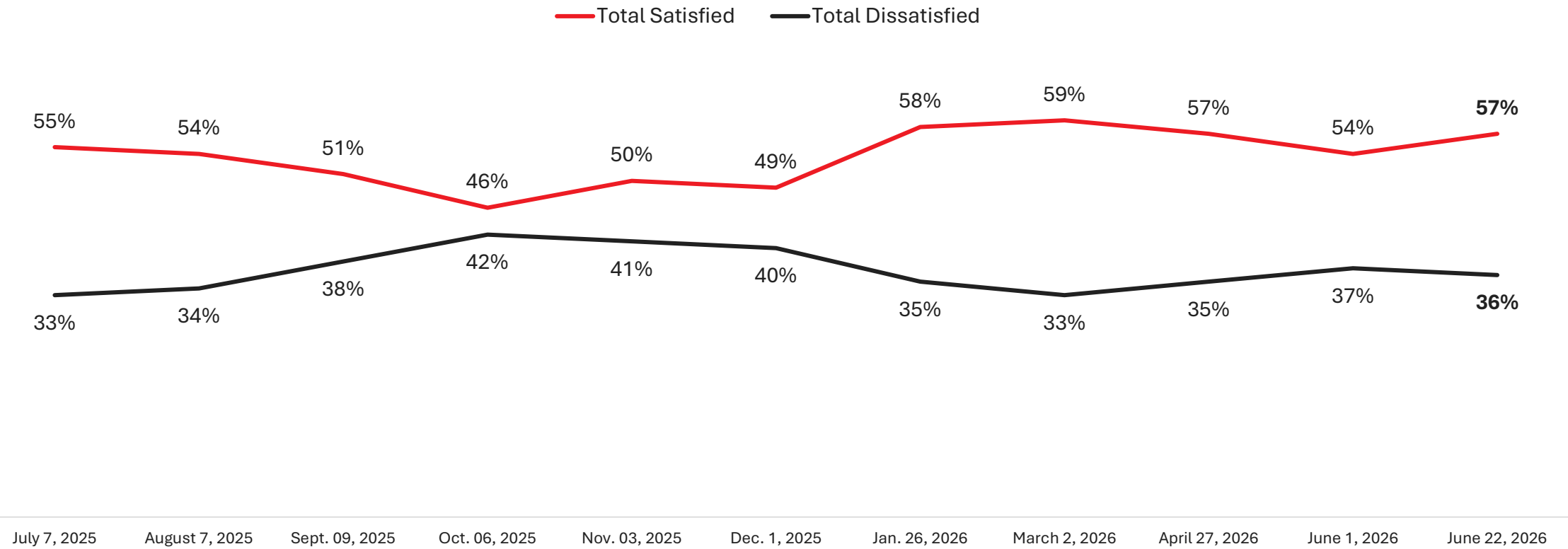

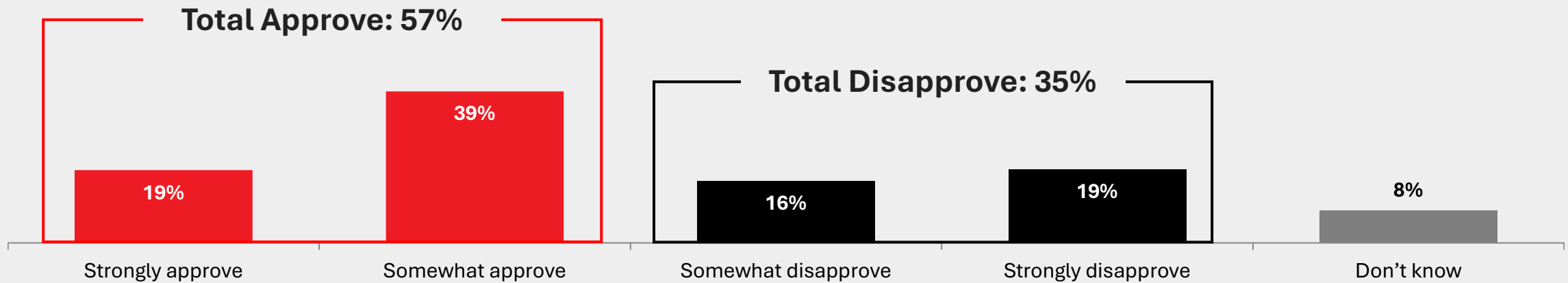

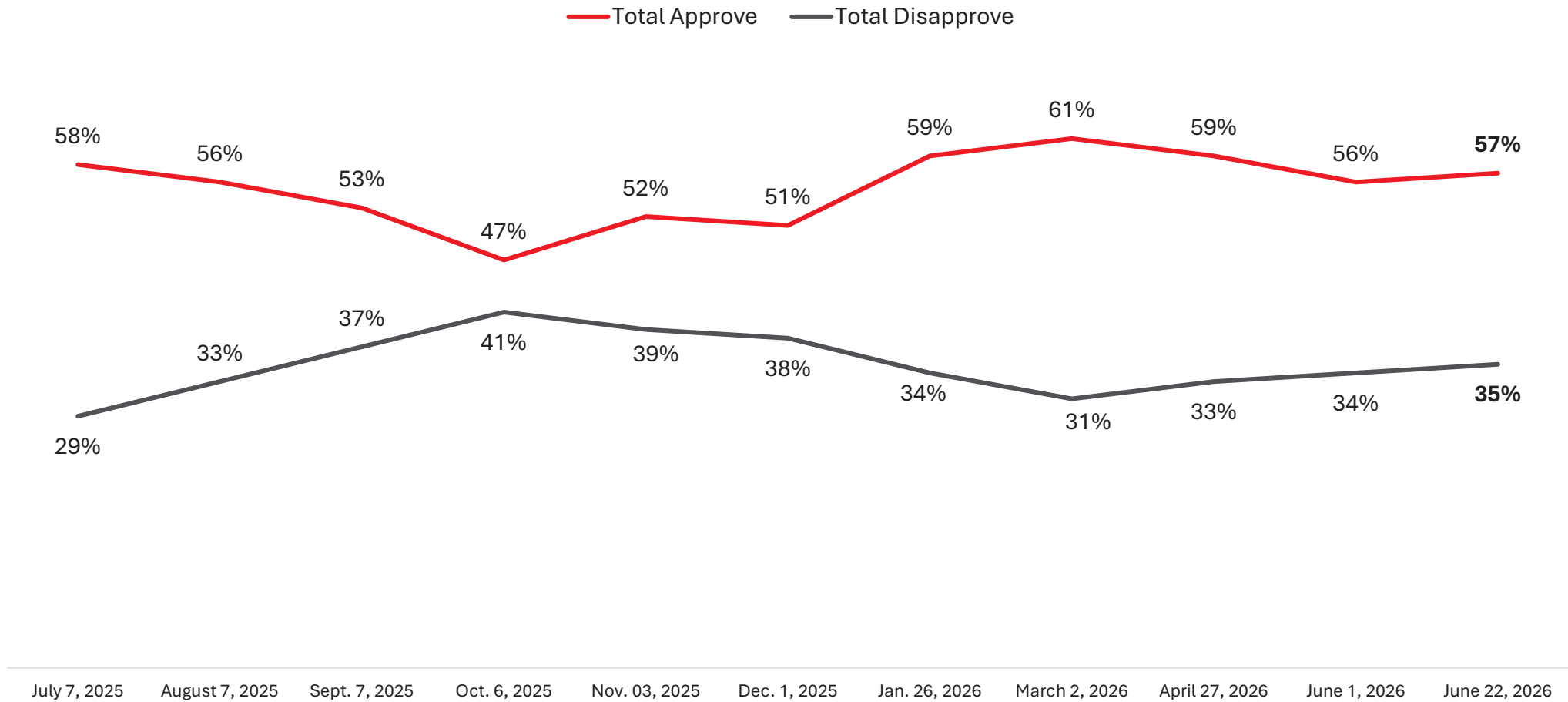
