A Survey of Canadians



August 4, 2026



Methodology

This week, we surveyed Canadians on politics, government performance, and key national issues.

Method

Online survey among respondents 18 years of age or older.
(Canadian sample: **n= 1,514**)

Respondents had the option of completing the survey in French and English and were randomly recruited using LEO's online panel.

Weighting

Results were weighted according to **age, gender, mother tongue, region, education and presence of children in the household** in order to ensure a representative sample of the Canadian population.

When

Data collection from **August 1st to August 3, 2026**.

Margin of error

For comparison purposes, a probability sample of this size yields a margin of error no greater than **±2.5%** (19 times out of 20) for the sample.

Significant Differences

Data in bold **red** characters indicate a significantly lower proportion than that of other respondents. Conversely, data in bold **green** characters indicate a significantly higher proportion than that of other respondents.

Rounded data

The numbers presented have been rounded up. However, the numbers before rounding were used to calculate the sums presented and might therefore not correspond to the manual addition of these numbers.

Key Highlights

Some of **the key highlights** of our survey...

FEDERAL VOTING INTENTIONS

- **The Liberals continue to lead nationally with 46% support among decided voters**, which is down two points since June 2026. Meanwhile, the Conservatives have remained stable at 34%. Support for the NDP has increased by two points to 8%. The Bloc Québécois remains at 6%, the Greens at 4%, and other parties at 2%.

GOVERNMENT PERFORMANCE & PRIME MINISTER CARNEY

- Canadians remain positive about the federal government, with 54% satisfied and 38% dissatisfied. Satisfaction declined by 3 percentage points compared with the previous month, though this change is not statistically significant. Satisfaction is highest among Canadians aged 55 and over (59%) and among Liberal voters (93%).
- Canadians' assessment of Prime Minister Mark Carney's performance is also positive, with 55% approving and 38% disapproving. Approval ratings are highest among Canadians aged 55 and over (61%) and Liberal voters (94%).
- Canadians' perceptions of the country's direction are somewhat divided: 54% say that Canada is on the right track, while 46% say that it is on the wrong track. Right-track perceptions are highest among Liberal voters (89%) and Canadians aged 55 and over (59%).

TRUST IN CARNEY AND POILIEVRE

- Mark Carney is more trusted than Pierre Poilievre across all six issues tested, with advantages ranging from 9 to 14 percentage points.
- Trust in Carney is highest on reducing immigration to ease pressure on healthcare and housing (69%), followed by accelerating major infrastructure and energy projects (64%). The largest gap between the two leaders is on increasing military spending and strengthening Canada's Arctic presence (60% for Carney vs. 46% for Poilievre).
- Both leaders receive their lowest trust ratings on negotiating a trade deal with the United States that may require Canadian concessions (50% for Carney and 38% for Poilievre).
- The narrowest gap relates to growing the energy sector while meeting climate commitments, although Carney still leads by 9 points (56% vs. 47%).

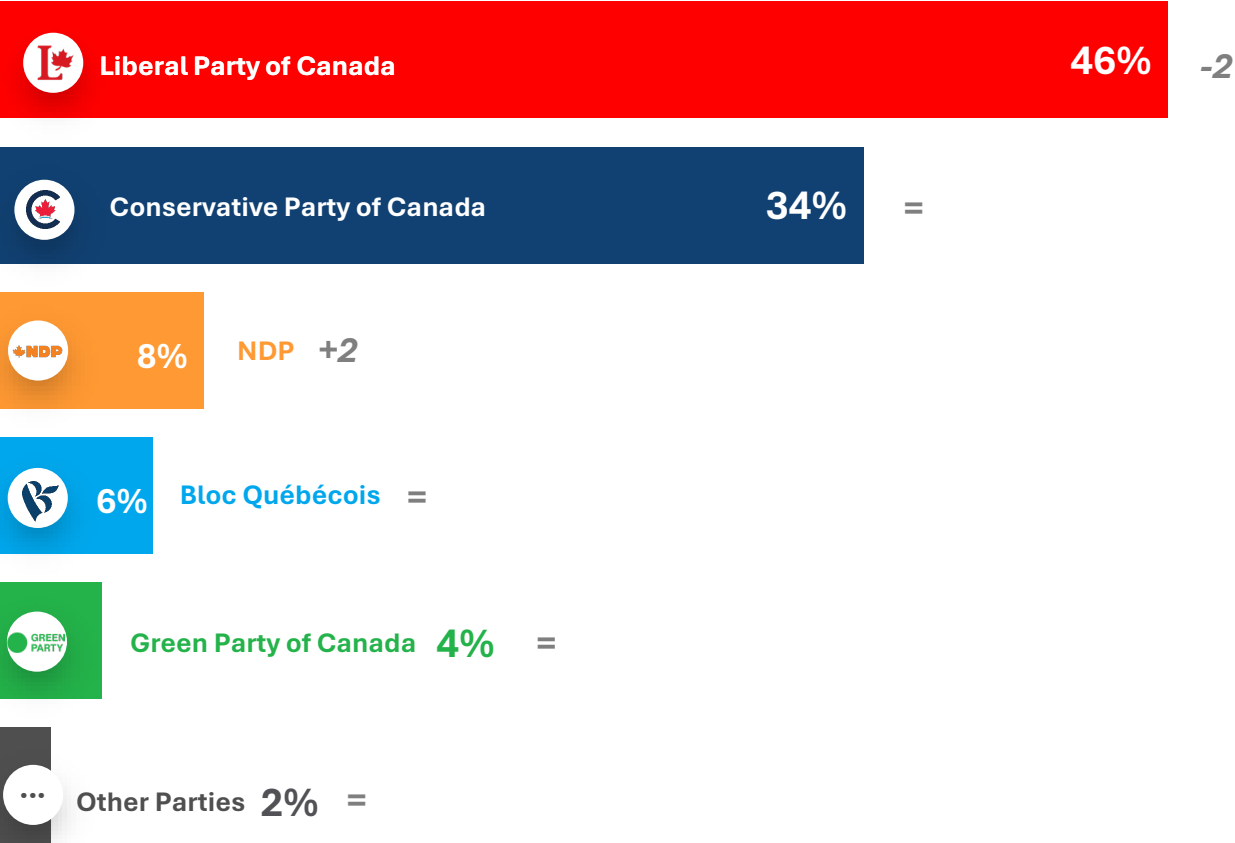
Federal Voting Intentions

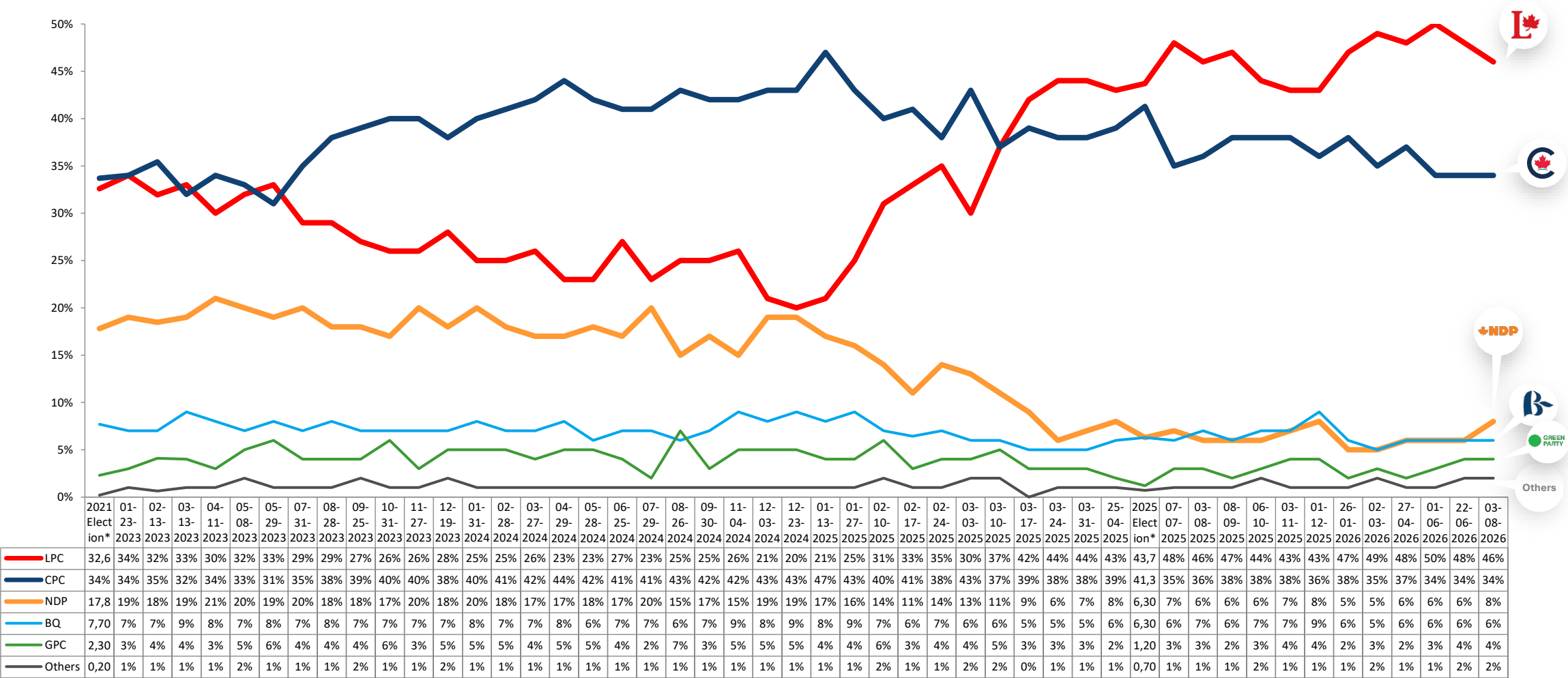

Evolution of Voting Intentions in Canada



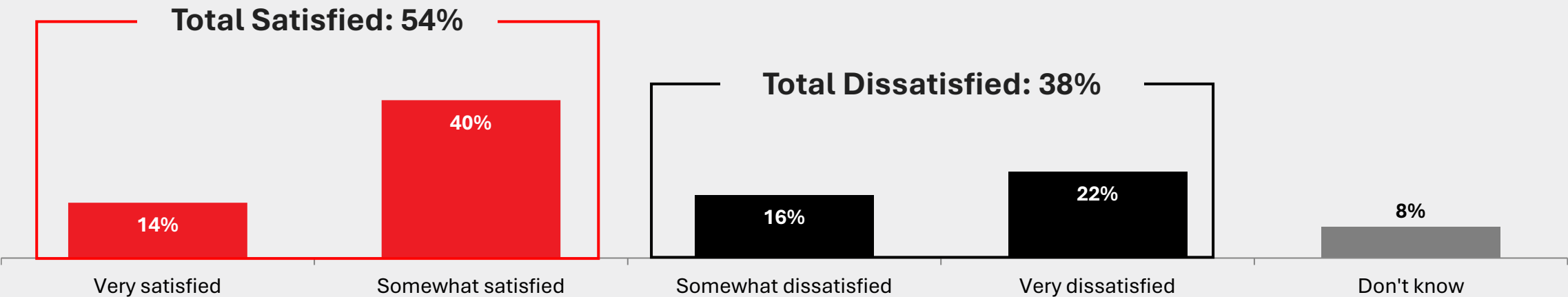

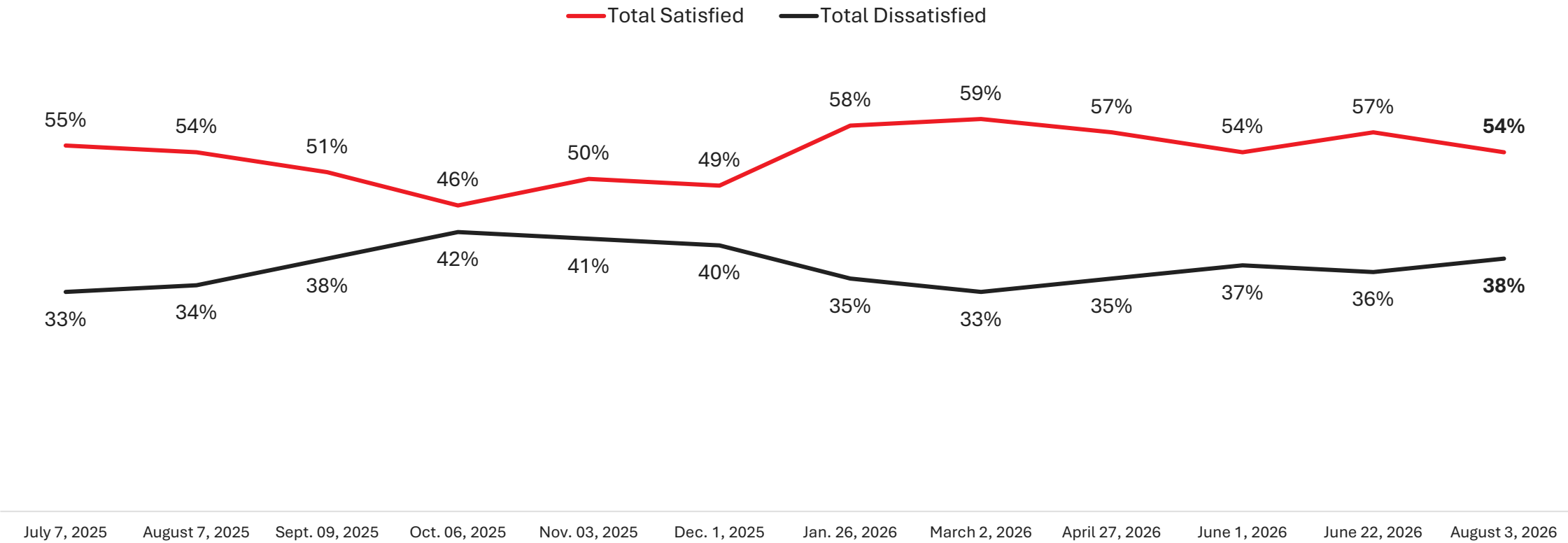

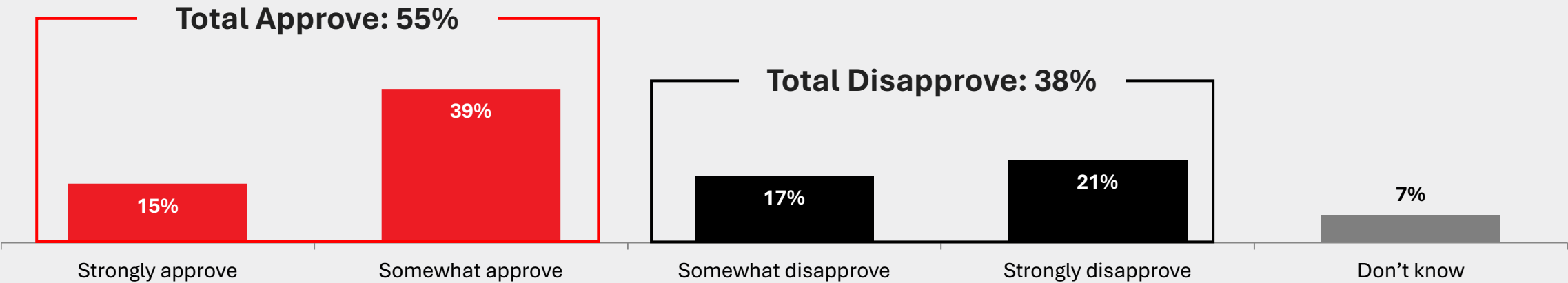

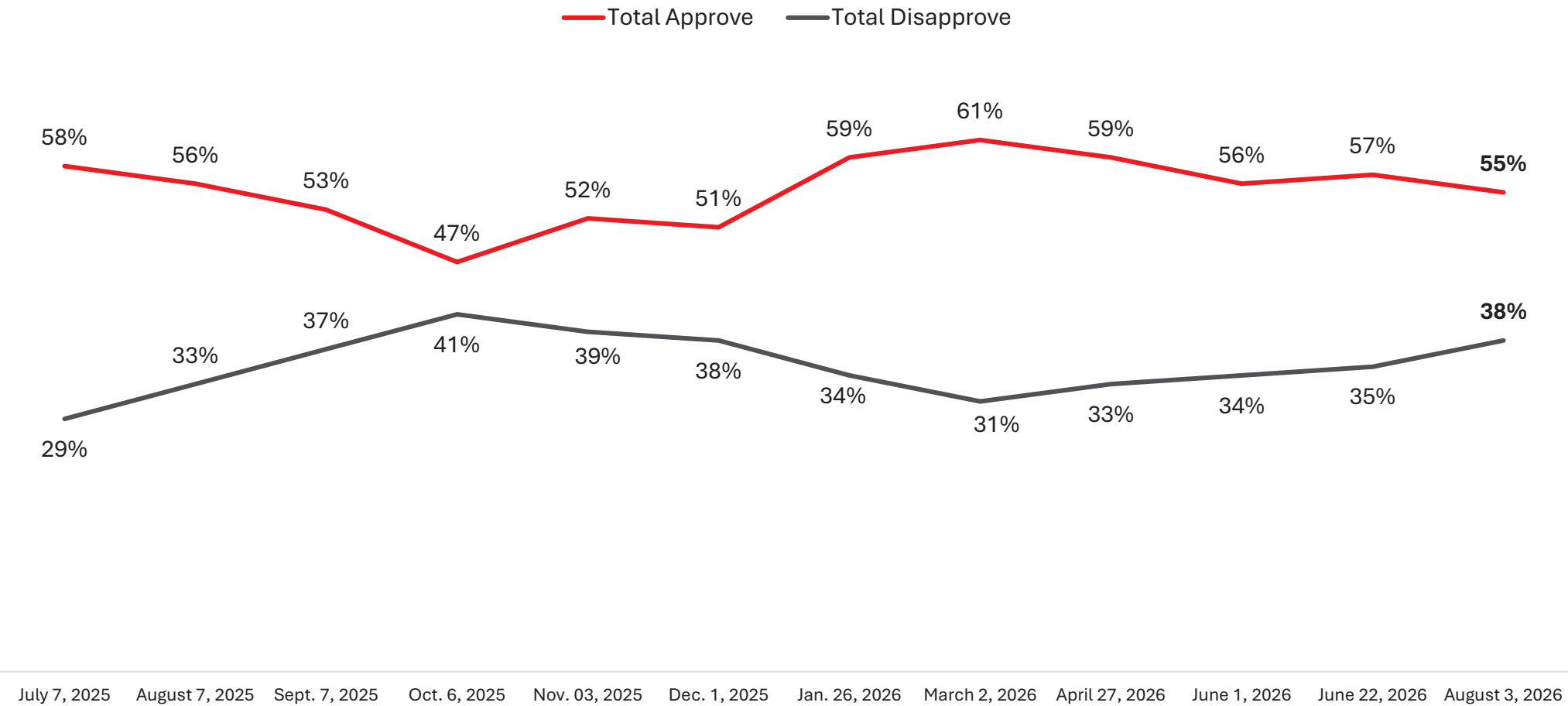

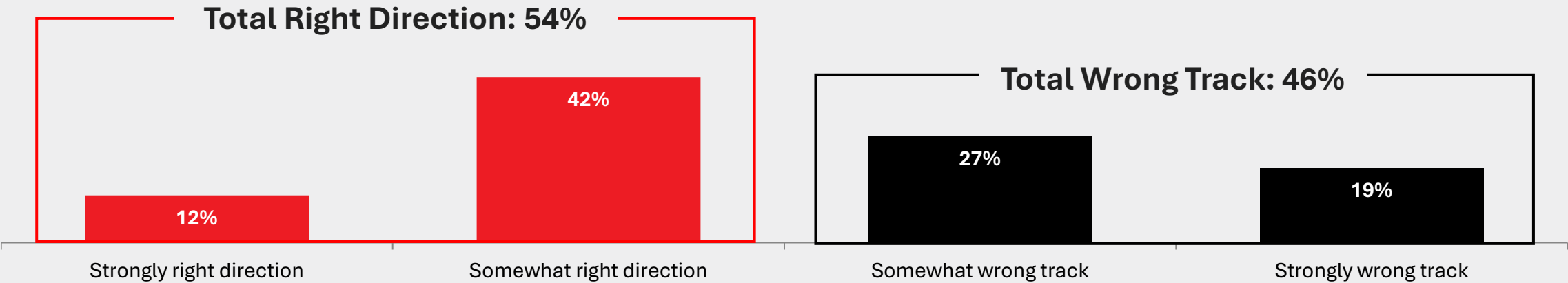

Overview of Trust in the Two Leaders Across Key Issues

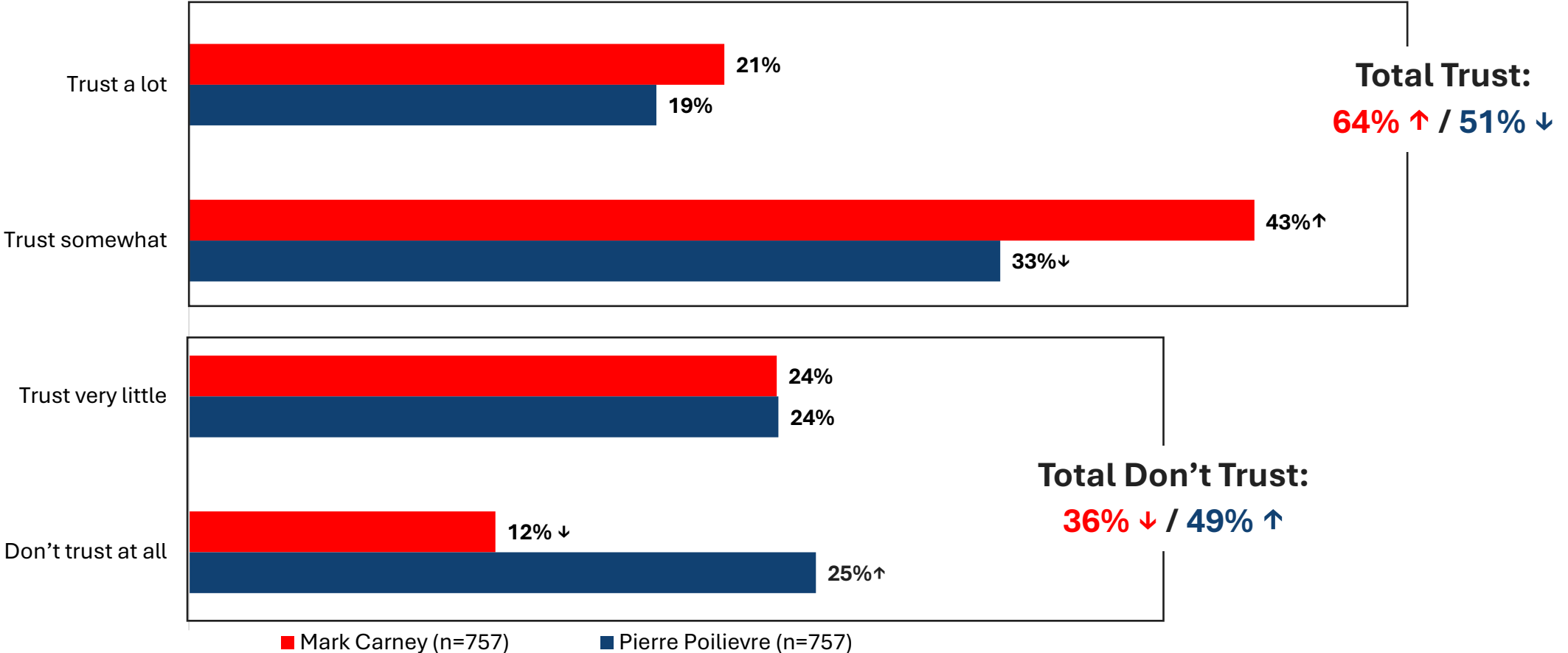
NOTE: For this section, six policy positions were selected on which Mark Carney's Liberals and Pierre Poilievre's Conservatives broadly share similar objectives, even if their proposed approaches may somewhat differ. The sample was randomly split into two equal groups: 757 respondents were asked how much they trusted Mark Carney on each policy, while 757 were asked the same questions about Pierre Poilievre. The policy positions were identical for both groups; only the leader referenced in the questions changed.

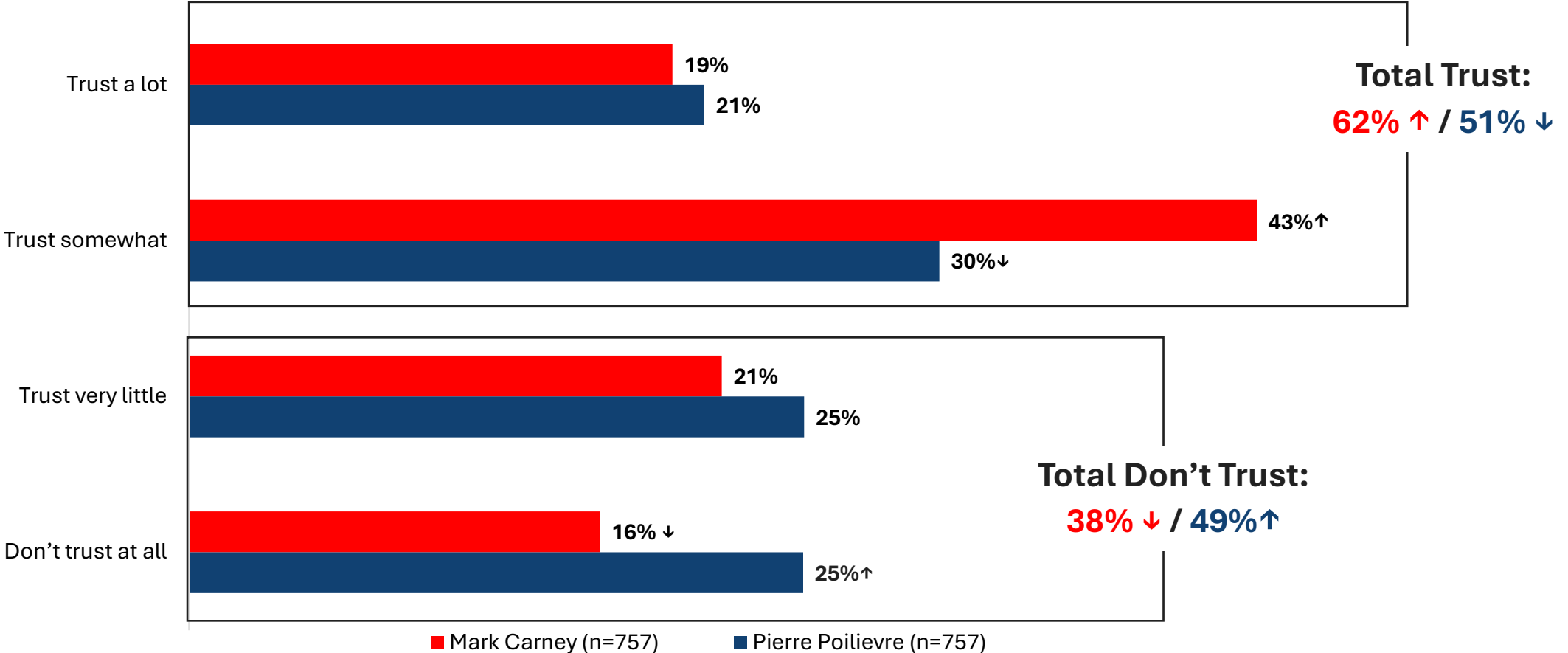

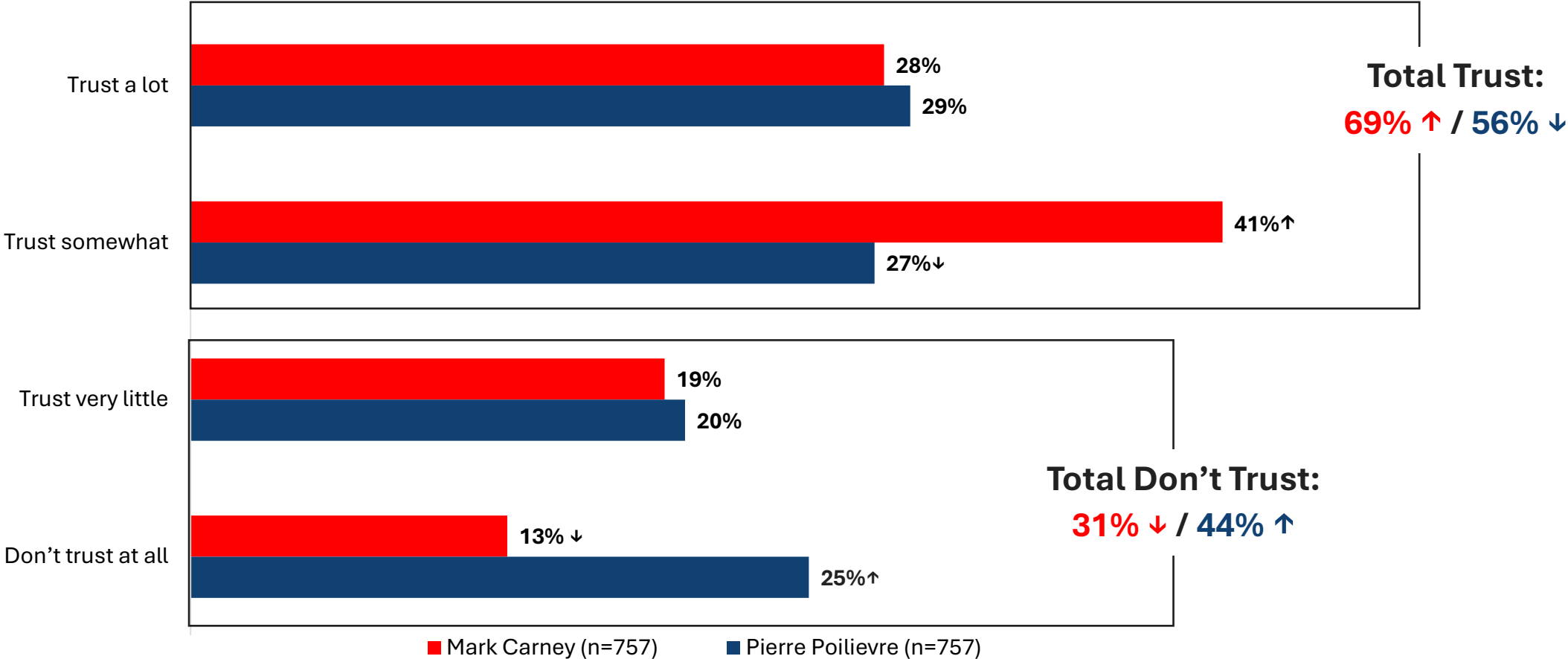

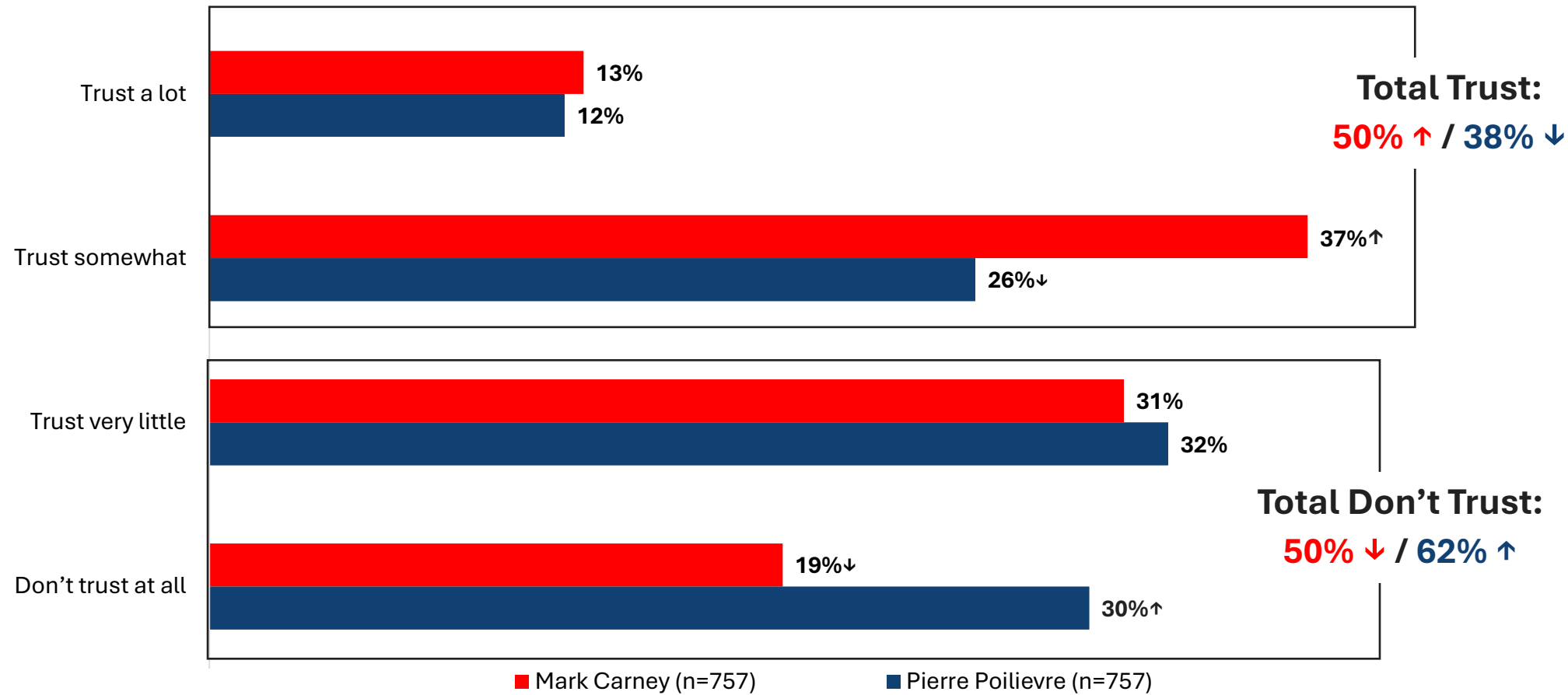

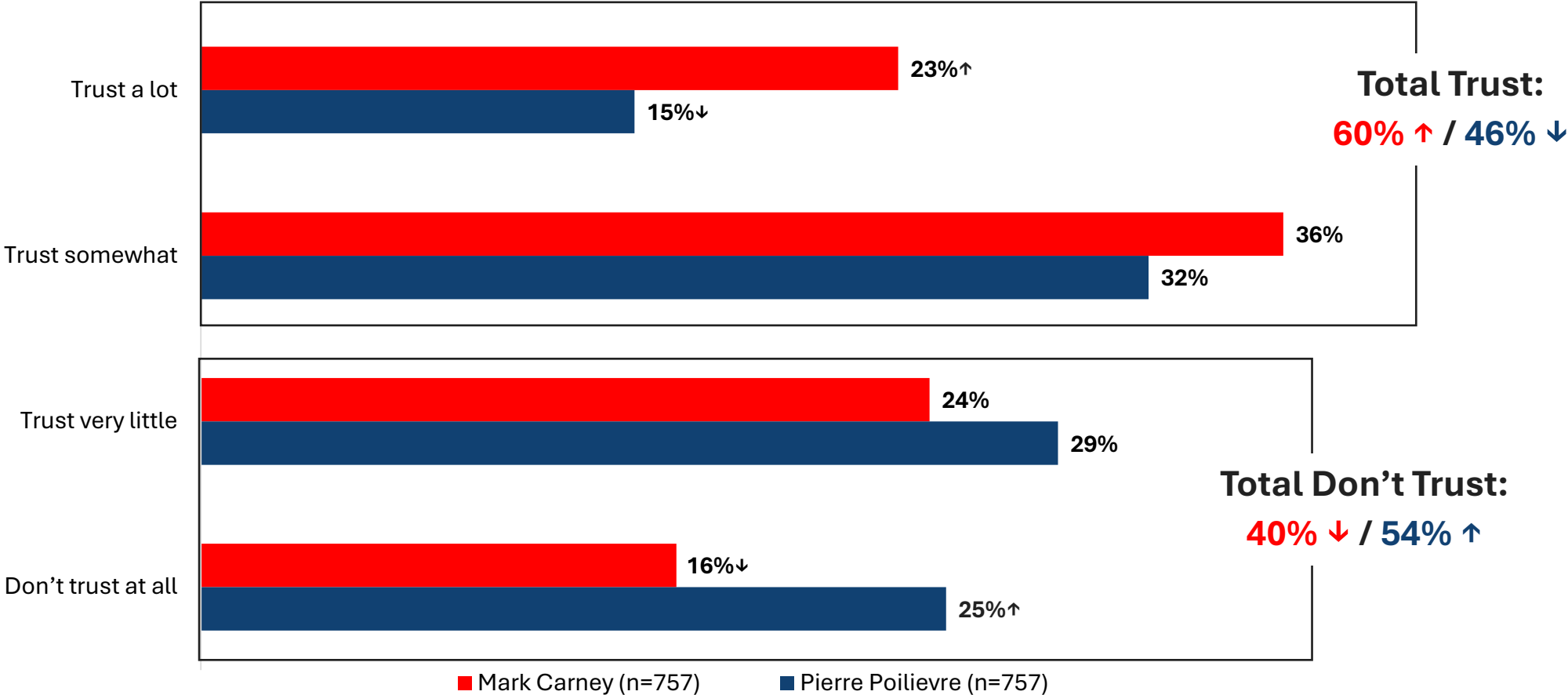

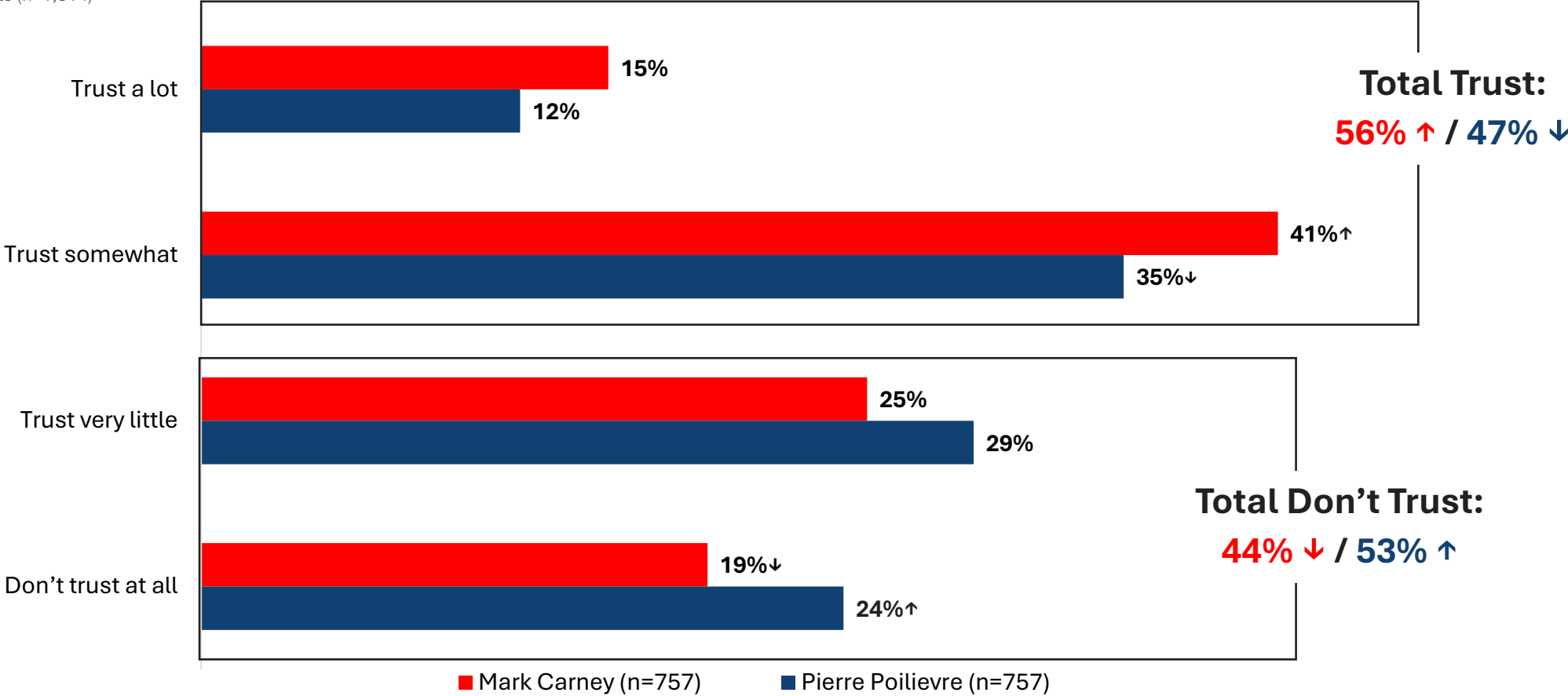

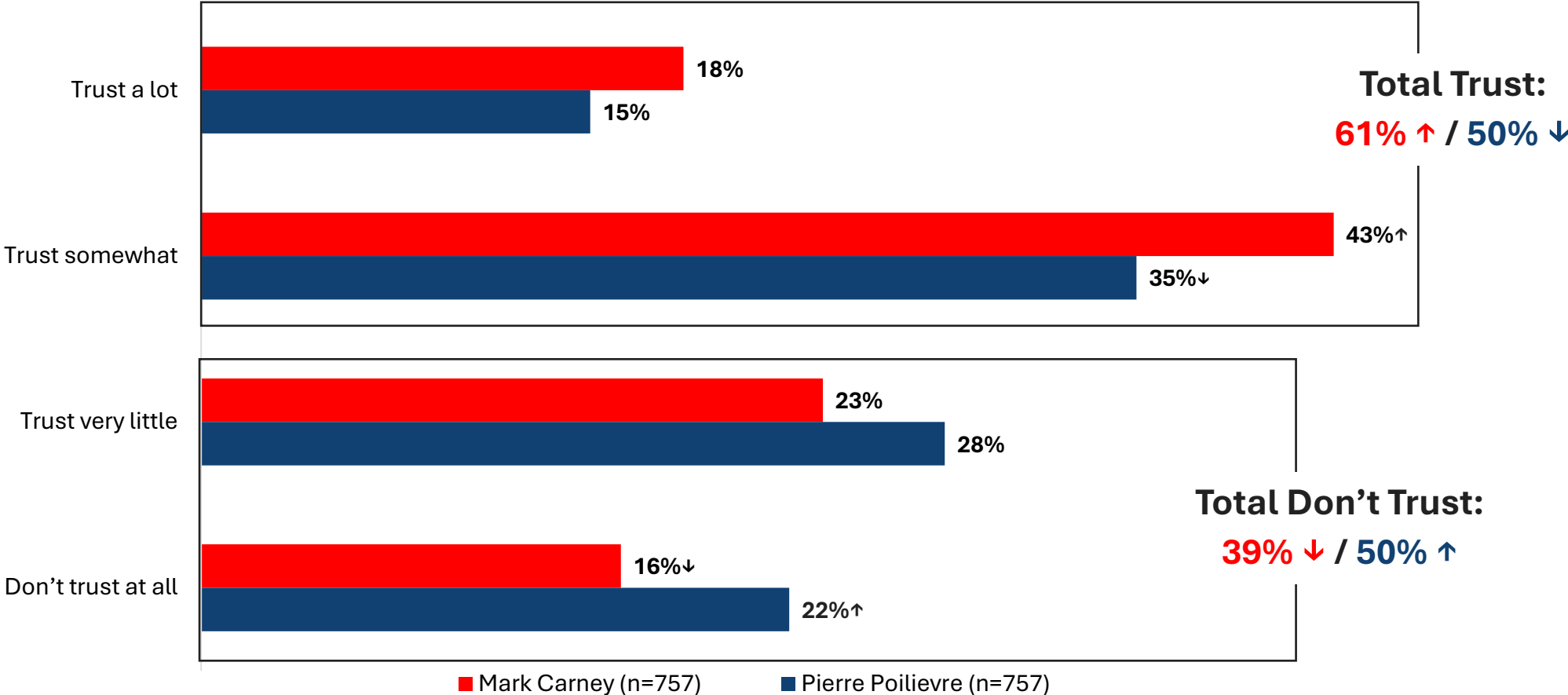
